



Terms of Engagement - If You've Enlisted Black Hawk Farm To Find You A Horse

Black Hawk Farm offers its sourcing service at 10% of the sale price of a horse. This means that Black Hawk Farm adds 10% to the amount a seller wants for their horse and the seller pays this 10% to Black Hawk Farm upon the sale of the horse. New Zealand sales tax (GST) must be added to this service charge.

Please be aware that you and anyone accompanying you are responsible for their own well being. Please wear appropriate safety equipment when riding any horses and be diligent around any horses.

Please be aware that acting swiftly will aid your cause. Many people will likely also be considering the horses you will be introduced to. If you are seriously interested in any particular horses it is in your best interests to view the horses as soon as possible, decide to vet a favoured horse near immediately, make your purchase decision within one day, and insure and pay for the horse near immediately. These are the timeframes parties typically operate within. It's not a race but acting promptly and decisively will work to your advantage.

Please inform Black Hawk Farm if you have enlisted additional Agents to find you a horse. This is in order to minimise embarrassment and disappointment to all parties involved.

And here's some fine print:

- All arrangements are governed by New Zealand law at all times.
- All amounts are in New Zealand Dollars unless stated otherwise.
- All parties are responsible for their own costs.
- A sourcing arrangement is in effect from the time these terms are accepted and until one party notifies the other party the arrangement is to be discontinued and any opportunities identified by Black Hawk Farm during the period of the arrangement remain subject to these Terms for 90 days following the discontinuation of the arrangement.
- If any of the buyers are under 18 years of age at the time of reviewing these Terms then please supply the name and contact details of their parents or a guardian.
