### Horse Purchase Costs Guideline

This worksheet is provided by Black Hawk Farm Limited to help people better understand the potential costs associated with purchasing a horse. This is a guide and not a quote or commitment. Actual costs will vary from purchase to purchase. Any amounts included here are believed to be representative at the time of writing. It is conventional practice in New Zealand for a horse to be supplied with a halter - all other gear is by negotiation. Please feel free to get in touch at any time if you have any questions.

<b>Personal transportation and accommodation</b> Flights, hotels/motels, food.	Highly variable	
<b>Vetting</b> Stage 1 & 2 for a recreational horse. Stage 5 for a competition horse. Cost varies by vet practice.	NZ\$350.00 to NZ\$2,000.00	
<b>Domestic transport</b> Trucking the horse from its prior home to its new home. Cost varies by distance and transporter.	AKL to WLG: NZ\$460.00 WLG to CHC: NZ\$460.00 AKL to CHC: NZ\$800.00	
<b>International transport</b> Air flights from country to country. Includes quarantine costs..	NZL to AUS: NZ\$5,000.00	
<b>Importation duty and tax</b> Varies greatly by country.	Entering AUS: 10% of purchase	
<b>Subtotal of possible costs</b> Add the amounts in the column titled "Your Cost"		
<b>Your budget</b>		
<b>Remaining for the horse itself (including any commission)</b> Subtract "Subtotal of possible costs" from "Your budget"
